Depending on the number of participants at a gathering or how many of your own ATCs you wish to share you too can start collecting these wonderful mini works of art. This is a wonderful way to network with other fabric artists and get exposed to different styles of art expressed through sewing, both by machine and by hand.

CREATING YOUR OWN ARTIST TRADING CARD:

Typically, an ATC is the size of a regular playing card, 3.5" X 2.5", but it can be as large as post card size, 6" X 4". Ordinarily the card is mounted on heavy card stock. All cards include the date of completion, signature of the artist, number if part of a limited edition and the artist's contact information.

With regards to subject matter, anything goes, and that goes for the execution of the project. Machine sewn, hand stitched, glued, beaded or stamped, allow your creative ideas to flow. You could actually begin with a much larger project and cut it into 3.5" X 2.5" pieces to finish them off and create a limited edition ATC. The addition of beads, netting and other usual elements gives depth to your artwork.
