



ARTIST TRADING CARDS SUPPLY LIST

1. Make as many of the ATCs that you want to trade.
2. Finished Size of ATC = Tradition ATC size—2.5”X3.5” or Quilter’s Post Card size—4”X6”
3. Batting—for the puffy look.
4. Various Fabrics—silks, satins, textured, printed, metallic, netting, and knobby fabric pieces.
5. Fusible Web—to fuse the small pieces of the artwork together and to further stabilize the project.
6. Sewing Machine—can be straight stitch only but decorative stitches can add nice detail.
7. Thread—embroidery threads, metallic, invisible, pearl cotton. All can add dimension and unexpected excitement to your ATC art piece.
8. Beads—bugle beads, flat, round, all different shapes, this can add glitz, glamour and special effects to your object d’art.
9. Timtex or Card Stock—the ATC is mounted on this material and can be purchased at any craft store.
10. Scissors, machine needles, hand sewing needles, thimble, and straight pins.
